

The Charles J. Miller Award

The Charles J. Miller award is the most prestigious award a person can receive from the Wonderland Camp Foundation. It is awarded in grateful recognition of extraordinary commitment and service to our camp. The Foundation is so very appreciative of our award recipients and looks forward to presenting the award to many future dedicated supporters.

Criteria

The Foundation Board of Directors considers the following criteria when evaluating a nominee for the CJM Award:

- Has served Wonderland Camp as a volunteer for a significant number of years;
- Has shown an *uncommon* commitment of time, treasure, or talent during the period of service to camp;
- Has made a unique contribution to camp; and
- Has been and will continue to be someone camp is proud to have as an ambassador.

Nominees may be individuals or organizations as long as there is no conflict of interest between the nominees and Wonderland Camp. Nominees may not be *current* staff members or board members, but they may be nominated after their employment or board service has ended.

Process

The Foundation Board of Directors considers nominations for the CJM Award at its regular fall meeting and votes on award recipients at its annual meeting. Winning the award requires a 90% “yes” vote of the members present.
